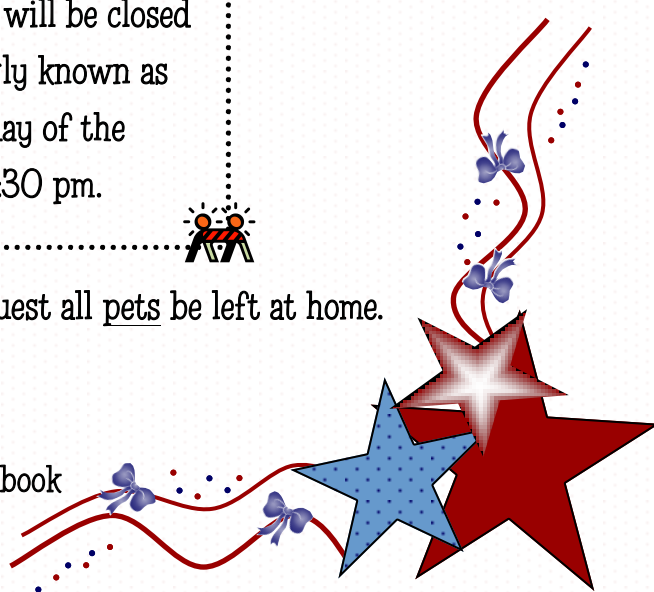

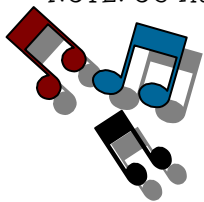

Aliso Viejo Community Association Homemade Apple Pie Contest



- Contestants must provide full name(s), phone number, address, email and submit entry to wcasar@pcmineternet.com no later than June 25th. Participants must reside within the City of Aliso Viejo and/or a current dues paying AVCA member.
- A minimum of six (6) entrees must be registered for contest or the contest is subject to cancellation.
- Contestants may check in beginning at 6:00 pm with their pie at the booth. All Pies must be checked in by 6:45 pm.
- Upon check-in, the contestant and the pie will be assigned a number. The pie will be labeled with the number on the pie pan and each judge's pie tasting plate.
- Contestants may remain present during pie judging.
- Any pies with cream toppings need to be submitted with some type of cooling storage to insure that it does not spoil prior to the judging. Please remember, there is no electricity available.
- All Apple Pie Contest Rules will be posted in the booth prior to commencement of the contest.
- Judging of all pies will be promptly at 7:00 pm.
- The Contest Director reserves the right to determine the order in which pies will be judged.
- Each judge will complete a pie-tasting score sheet for each contestant. Judging will be based upon, but not limited to: presentation of pie, appearance of pie, freshness of pie, originality of recipe; tastiness of crust, texture of filling, flavor of filling, sweetness of flavor, etc. The judges may also make additional comments on the score sheets.
- As each pie sample is tasted, the judges will complete their score sheets and turn them into the Contest Director.
- The score sheets will be collected for each contestant and tallied at the conclusion of all tasting.
- Scores will be tallied by the Contest Director and checked by another party to verify.
- The contestant with the highest combined score from the judges will be declared the winner.
- The Apple Pie Contest Winner will be announced and receive their prizes on stage at approximately 8:00 pm.
- Photographs will be taken of the winners for the community newsletter and website.
- Upon conclusion of the pie judging and the announcement of the winner(s), **the contestants must return to the booth to pick up their pie.**
- NOTE: OC Health Regulations does not permit pies to be served to the public.
